

## International Fellowship of Railroading Rotarians

Annual Meeting – June 22, 2010

### Minutes

The meeting took place in Room 521 of the Palais de Congres; Montreal, Canada during the Rotary International Convention. It was very well attended by over 16 members and guests.

President Don Schiller opened the meetings and welcomed everyone.

1. Don gave an update of the history of IFRR explaining what has taken place during the past two years. Bylaws for this fellowship have been drafted and approved by the executive Board. George Rigney agreed to be our Treasurer.

There being no further nominations this executive Board was acclaimed elected.
