#### 1. The Annual Meeting of IFRR at lunch, Tuesday June 3.

Excursion to the layouts at the Australian Model Railway Association at Mortdale After the annual meeting walk to the Olympic Park Railway Station to meet member Jim Wells who will lead on the two leg commuter train trip to the facility. Epping 1514-transfer to suburban train-1525

Macq Park 1532-1548-see large underground station

Return to Central at 1624 via Harbour Bridge.
